MESSAGE ARTICLE – DECEMBER 2017**Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.**

December is usually the month in which we celebrate HANUKKAH and we all could use a refresher course regarding the procedures and *HALACHOT* for the kindling of the lights of the HANUKKIAH, and so I have tried to be as meticulous as I could with the details in this year's message. Of course, if you have any questions you can always ask me.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIGHTING THE HANUKKIAH**TIMES FOR LIGHTING THE HANUKKIAH**

- Except before and after Shabbat, light the HANUKKIAH as soon after dark as possible.
- HANUKKAH must burn for at least ½ hour [on *SHABBAT* for 1½ hours]
- Before *SHABBAT*:
 1. First light the HANUKKIAH so that it can burn for 1½ hours
 2. Then light the *SHABBAT* candles at least 18 minutes before sunset.
- After *SHABBAT*:

In the Synagogue, light the HANUKKIAH before *HAVDALLAH*.
At home, light the HANUKKIAH after *HAVDALLAH*.

SETTING UP THE HANUKKIAH:

1. Arrange the lights of a flame kindled HANUKKIAH as follows:

While looking at the HANUKKIAH, place the light representing the 1st night on the extreme right, on the 2nd night – 1 light for the first night, 2 lights for the second night and keep adding additional lights – to the left – for each subsequent night of HANUKKAH. The light for each subsequent night of HANUKKAH should be kindled first with the kindling continuing from right to left and so forth for each subsequent night.
2. Place the additional light – the *SHAMMASH* – into its distinct location.

An electric HANUKKIAH may be placed at a window – for safety reasons – such that it is visible from outside your home. This fulfills the observance of *PIRSUMEI NEIS* – proclaiming the miracle of HANUKKAH to all who pass by.

The lights of an electric HANUKKIAH *should* be positioned – beginning on the extreme left – and appear as if they are being lit in the opposite direction of a flame kindled

HANUKKIAH – adding an additional bulb to the right each night. An electric HANUKKIAH does not take the place of a flame kindled HANUKKIAH.

3. Place the additional **SHAMMASH** – working light – into its distinct location.

KINDLING THE LIGHTS AND THE B'RACHOT:

1. Light the **SHAMMASH** first.
2. Before kindling the other lights, recite the **B'RACHOT**
BARUCH ATAH ADONAI ELOHEINU MELECH haOLAM ASHER KID'SHANU
B'MITZVOTAV V'TZIVANU L'HADLIK NEI SHEL HANUKKAH.

BARUCH ATAH ADONAI ELOHEINU MELECH haOLAM SHE'ASAH NISIM
LAVOTEINU BAYAMIM HAHEIM u'VAZMAN haZEH.

On the first night only add:

BARUCH ATAH ADONAI ELOHEINU MELECH haOLAM SHEHEHEYANU
v'KIY'MANU v'HIGIANU laZ'MAN haZEH.

3. Use the **SHAMMASH** to kindle the 1st [left most] light.
4. Proceeding left to right, use the **SHAMMASH** to kindle the remaining lights.
 - while reciting haNEIROT haLALU, if reciting from memory.
 - before reciting haNEIROT haLALU, if reciting from a text.
5. Chant **MAOZ TZUR**

President's Message December 2017


Shalom All!

First, we want to wish you all a happy and healthy Hanukkah.








