MESSAGE ARTICLE – OCTOBER 2017 Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.

The first two weeks of the month of October this year, are consumed with preparations for and the observance of the Festival of *Sukkot*. I believe that the ritual aspects of *Sukkot* are the most intense of all the Festivals. Some may say that the observance of the Festival of Passover is more difficult. Certainly, a case could be made that assuring everything is *KASHER L'PESA<u>H</u>* is more time consuming and even back-breaking than *Sukkot*, but once that has been accomplished, the rest of the ritual observance of Passover seems to proceed fairly smoothly.

In the *Talmud*, the Festival of Sukkot was called HeHag-THE Holiday. And, indeed, King Solomon dedicated the original *Beit HaMikdash* in *Y'rushalayim* during *Sukkot*. In terms of ritual *Sukkot* poses additional challenges: reciting Full Hallel for its duration, *Hoshana Rabbah* [the seventh day of the *Sukkot*] is almost a Holiday by itself. And then we have *Sh'mini Atzeret*[the eighth Day] which IS a Holiday by itself. And the second day of *Sh'mini Atzeret*, which we call *Simhat Torah*, is observed by those of us outside *Eretz Yisrael*. And the special *Hoshanot*, circling around the Sanctuary, with a *Sefer Torah* and *Lulavim* except on *Shabbat*.

With all of this going on for *Sukkot*, I just wanted to focus on the *mitzvah* of *n'tillat lulav*, the taking or waving the *lulav*. This requires *arba'ah minim* the four species – 1- *Lulav* [one palm branch], 2- *Etrog* [one citron], 3- *Hadasim* [three myrtle branches], 4-*Aravot* [two willow branches]. They are often referred to under the inclusive term *lulav*, since the *lulav* is the largest and most prominent of the species. All the species are placed in a special holder made of woven palm fronds and tied with side fronds from this or another *lulav*. Thus, while the *mitzvah* is to wave the *lulav*, this actually refers to waving all four species: palm, willow, myrtle and *Etrog*. Also, when people refer to the *lulav* and *etrog*, they are referring to all four species, including the willow and myrtle branches. It is considered an act of *hiddur mitzvah* – the beatification of the *mitzvah* of the observance of the Holiday – to acquire the *arba'ah minim* as fresh and unblemished as available, so that their beauty enhances our enjoyment of the Festival. It is a *mitzvah* to wave the *lulav* on each of the first seven days of *Sukkot*. The proper time is in the morning — either before the morning service or during the service immediately before the *Hallel*.




