Some years ago, I became acquainted with a man who survived being an eyewitness to Kristallnacht - the night of broken glass in Germany on November 9-10, 1938. At that time Fred was 10 years old. His parents saw the handwriting on the wall and made plans for him and his younger sister to flee the oncoming disaster. He, alone, survived the hazards that followed – losing his sister along the way and never again seeing his parents after leaving Germany. Why am I telling you this story at this happy occasion? Because, Fred came and spoke to my Hebrew School students and told them about his incredible journey to America. After his remarks, one of my students, who happened to be about 10 years old, asked Fred, "who took care of you on your journey to America?" He told them that, in each town to which he came, he looked for a Jewish Synagogue and in that Synagogue there was most often a Sisterhood. It was the women of the Sisterhood who fed and sheltered him for a brief time and gave him sustenance enough to hopefully get to the next town, in his dangerous and incredible journey, where the women of the Sisterhood there repeated the same scenario.

Madison Jewish Center's Sisterhood is the spiritual descendant of the women who helped save the life of my friend Fred. Shelli and Harriett have added their unique talents to keep our Sisterhood's programming vibrant and sometimes acting in conjunction with our other affiliates in the all-important and essential fundraising activities. Both Harriett and Shelli, in their own quiet and subdued manner have succeeded in motivating others in our Sisterhood to step up to help and assist in the essential work they do. Madison Jewish Center, in no small way, has been able to survive to our current 87th Anniversary Year because of the past and current dedication of the leaders of our Sisterhood. To Shelli and Harriett a special YASHAR KOHACHEN -MORE POWER TO THE BOTH YOU. May our Sisterhood and Madison Jewish Center continue to be blessed into the future with the high standards of leadership that Harriett Cohen and Shelli Feldman have established.
