MESSAGE ARTICLE – SEPTEMBER 2018 Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.

Ready! Set! Repent! If only it could be that easy. When the Jewish Calendar beckons all of us to the synagogue for *Rosh haShannah*, our tradition considers the *Midrash* that states: *Kol ha<u>H</u>alot Kashot* – all beginnings are difficult. And so, to achieve one of the enormously difficult goals of this time of year – <u>Heshbon haNefesh</u> – taking a spiritual accounting of our souls it was divided into stages. This allows us to come to grips with our own shortcomings and the finite time we are granted to achieve our favorably being sealed for blessing in the Book of Life.

The first step is the *S'lihot_*Service of Penitential Prayers. This year *S'lihot_*begins on Saturday night September 1st. We will be gathering with our sister congregation Temple Sholom here at Madison for film and socialization at 8:30pm followed by our *S'lihot_*Service. We recite *S'lihot* prayers beginning the Saturday night before *Rosh haShannah* to adequately prepare for the upcoming – *Aseret Y'mei T'shuvah* - the ten days of repentance. In a year when *Rosh haShannah* begins on a Sunday night or Monday night, as it does this year, we begin *S'lihot* a week earlier giving us that much more time to prepare in advance for *Rosh haShannah*. We do this as a sign of our eagerness to begin this important process.

Before *S'lihot* there is the meaningful ritual of changing the Torah covers and Ark curtains to white, which are specifically designed for the High Holidays. This color represents purity and the wish that through repentance, our sins will be made white as snow (Isaiah 1:18). You are invited to join our Ritual Committee on Thursday evening August 30th at 6:00pm for the changing of the covers and curtains.
