MESSAGE ARTICLE – OCTOBER 2018

Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.

In my birth year, I was born on the 2nd day of *ROSH haSHANNAH*. Since the secular date of my birth, October 1st, and the 2nd day of *ROSH haSHANNAH* do not always coincide, Jewishly speaking - a case could be made that I am actually only three years old. This year in the Jewish Calendar we will be celebrating one of my favorite holidays - *Simhat Torah* - which begins with our Parade of Torah Service in the Main Sanctuary - at 7:00pm the evening of October 1st. I invite all of you to join me on this and my special day.

Just to let everyone know here are some of the *Minhagim* that we observe here at Madison for *Simhat Torah*.

- The biblical verses, beginning with *Atah Horeita* - which is found in the *Siddur* - are recited antiphonally i.e. first by the *Hazan* and then by the congregation.
- We carry all our *Sifrei Torah* in 7 *Hakafot* [processions around the sanctuary]. For the last one we proceed outside, weather permitting.
- The *Hakafot* proceed counter clockwise around the sanctuary.
- During each *Hakafah* the assigned liturgical lines are sung antiphonally, followed by familiar Jewish songs some of which are heard at Jewish weddings.
- Dancing in the aisles is permitted and encouraged.
- The one *Sefer Torah*, from which the *Hazan* will chant is taken to the *Amud* [the Torah reading lectern] while the others are placed back in the *Aron haKodesh*.
- This is the only occasion in the entire Jewish calendar year when a Torah portion is chanted at a public worship service in the evening.
- For *Simhat Torah*, so that everyone is given an honor, group *Aliyot* [calling up to do the blessings before and after the Torah which include women in our egalitarian synagogue] are as follows: 1-All *Kohanim* including *B'not Kohanim* daughters of a *Kohein*. 2-All *L'vi'im* including *B'not L'vi'im* daughters of a *Levi*. 3-All the remaining men. 4-All the remaining women. 5- All the children.

Just to let you know our monthly Birthday/Anniversary Shabbat for September was inadvertently overlooked. We will be combining September and October Birthday/Anniversary Shabbat on Sisterhood Shabbat Friday night October 19th. Services, led by the women of Sisterhood, begin at

7:30pm in the Main Sanctuary. The Sisterhood Shabbat Dinner is at 6:15pm in our newly renovated ballroom – reservations for dinner are a must.

I look forward to seeing all of you at these special and joyous celebrations.

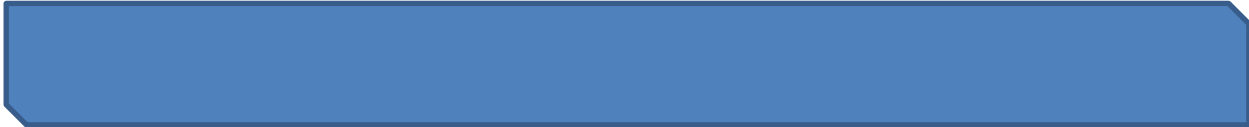

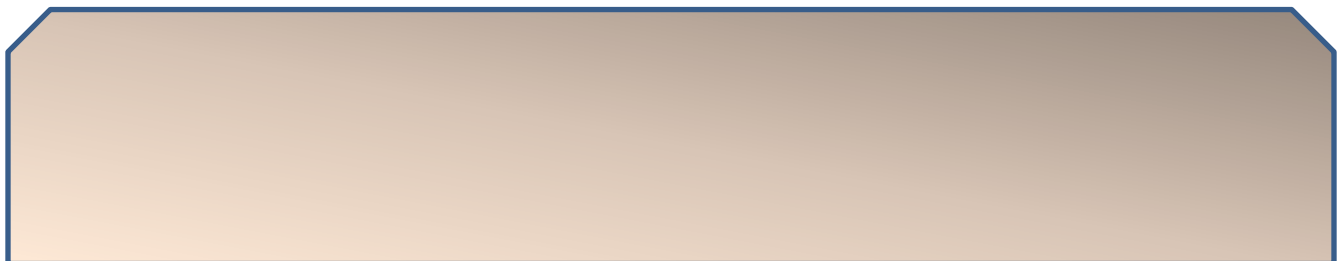
