### MESSAGE ARTICLE – NOVEMBER 2018 Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.

There are different ways to say thank you in every language. That is why, when we travel, if we are wise, thank you is typically one of the very first phrases we strive to learn. It's that important. We instinctively understand that expressing gratitude will warm people's hearts. When others know that we appreciate their efforts, they are much more inclined to help us. It's the same reason why we emphasize, "Say thank you" to our children. We want them to understand that we can't take for granted anything that others do for us. In fact, we can't take anything for granted.

The morning prayer "Modeh/Modah [f.] ani— I am thankful," has been the first spoken words of the day on the lips of Jews for centuries. Gratitude is essential to our spiritual well-being. The word Jew itself – comes from the Hebrew Y'hudah – and has the same Hebrew root as the word todah -thankful. We are the people of thankfulness. Gratitude is the foundation of our religious life. In America we have a whole holiday, which we celebrate this month of November, focusing on expressing appreciation- Thanksgiving. As Jews, we know that EVERY day is Thanksgiving.

Giving thanks and expressing gratitude is as important to our spiritual well-being as water is to our physical well-being. We live in an incredibly fast paced and consumer-oriented culture. Both characteristics stand in the way of cultivating gratitude. We often move through our days, through our weeks, through our lives, in such a hurry, that we fail to appreciate the extraordinary blessings in our lives. Our culture conspires to inculcate dissatisfaction. We enjoy overwhelming material comforts unlike any of our ancestors, and yet we want more and more. Since most of us never have enough, we never have the newest and we never have the best, we are in constant pursuit of them and don't take time to appreciate and enjoy what we have. We feel deprived in the midst of bounty and grow bitter and consumed with the desire to have more. Cultivating gratitude is the antidote to this spiritual depression.

Every day should be Thanksgiving, and in the Jewish world, every day is Thanksgiving. Our goal is to find opportunities, every day - not just one day a year, to stop and notice the blessings we enjoy and say thank you. Living with gratitude elevates our entire life. It guides us into becoming a

more joyful person. We then become a kinder and more compassionate person. And we can become a person who lives in greater harmony with others. All of this comes from giving THANKS!

Let this Thanksgiving Holiday be a reminder and an encouragement to us as *Y'hudim* - the appreciative ones, that counting our blessings is our foundational spiritual path, and one that will bring us strength and a sense of holiness through all the joys and challenges of our lives.


