MESSAGE ARTICLE – SEPTEMBER 2019**Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.**

For many Jews, the High Holiday season begins with Rosh haSHannah and the start of the new month of *Tishrei*. Jewish tradition, however, teaches that the preceding month of *Elul* is a time of soul-searching and reflection to prepare oneself for the magnitude of *Aseret Y'mei T'shuvah*, the Ten Days of Repentance, The Days of Awe between Rosh haSHannah and Yom Kippur. On the Saturday night before Rosh haSHannah we hold *S'lihot Services*. Tradition requires that there be at least four days between *S'lihot Services* and Rosh haSHannah.

This year, *S'lihot Services* will be held jointly at Temple Sholom at 8:00pm on Saturday night Sept 21st.

In its broadest definition, *s'lihot* are penitential prayers said before and during the High Holidays and other fast days throughout the year. But the term first appears as a reference to the biblical verses that were added to the liturgy. The *siddur* of Rav Amram Gaon, from the ninth century, for example, includes a collection of these penitential prayers and meditations. While these prayers were initially only recited during the days between Rosh haSHannah and Yom Kippur, eventually, they were combined with general prayers of repentance recited during daily worship services throughout the year.

In Hebrew, *s'lihot* is a plural noun which best translates to “forgivenesses,” and indeed there is an emphasis in these prayers on the merciful attributes with which *haSHem* is said to govern the world. In many ways, the prayers which make up the *S'lihot* service mirror what we find on the Day of Atonement which follows soon after. The language of these qualities should sound familiar to anyone who has recited the liturgy throughout Yom Kippur when we speak about *haSHem's* ability to forgive “transgressions, iniquities, and sins.” We begin and end the season of repentance with the same words, calling out to *haSHem* who we hope will accept our prayers.

It is customary to change the *Torah* covers, Arc curtains and *Bimah* lectern covers during the week before *S'lihot* to those specifically designed for the High Holidays. These special covers and curtains are usually white, representing purity and the wish that through repentance, our sins will be made as white as snow (Isaiah 1:18).

On a lighter note, one of the highlights of August at MJC was a Musical Shabbat with Rabbi and Arlene Kane. Together, we welcomed Shabbat and raised our voices in joyous celebration of the gift of the Sabbath, carrying on the tradition of greeting the arrival of the Shabbat with music, song and gladness.

As September arrives, we look forward to our High Holy Days - Rosh HaShannah and Yom Kippur, the Succah Raising and the Parade of the Torahs. As our Madison community joins together in observance of Jewish custom and tradition, ritual and prayer, please join us for services and enjoy a brief respite from the weekday stress. L'Dor v'Dor
