**MESSAGE ARTICLE – MARCH 2020****Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.**

**We hope you will all join us here at Madison Jewish Center on Monday Evening March 9, 2020 as we celebrate the Feast of *Purim*. The Reading of the *M'gillah* will begin at 6:00pm followed by our Costume Parade, *Purim* Carnival and hmnTaschen.**

**Just as a reminder there are 4 *Mitzvot* associated with the celebration or *Purim*:**

- 1. *Mikra M'gillah* – the requirement for all to listen to the Reading of the *M'gillah*.**
- 2. *Mattanot laEvyonim* – as we express our joy in celebrating *Purim*, we fulfill the *Mitzvah* of giving to the poor. This usually takes the form of making sure that those less fortunate than we are, not only have the wherewithal to obtain enough food to observe *Purim*, but that they have the other necessities to live a want free life. Following the Reading of the *M'gillah*, there will be 3 baskets, outside the Main Sanctuary, for you to make a donation to fulfill this *Mitzvah*.**
- 3. *Mishloah Manot* - the giving of gifts of food and drink to family and friends. If you wish a calorie free alternative, our Sisterhood has established, the *Minhag* [custom] here at Madison, of selling *Purim Mishloah Manot* cards to be mailed to family and friends on *Purim*, thereby, helping us to cut down on our calorie intake. Call the Synagogue office for more information.**
- 4. *S'udat Purim* – the joyous *Purim* Feast, which usually takes place in the afternoon and extends into the evening. Along with the food and drink there can be a *Purim Schpeil* – consisting of the performance of humorous parodies and skits on *Purim* themes.**

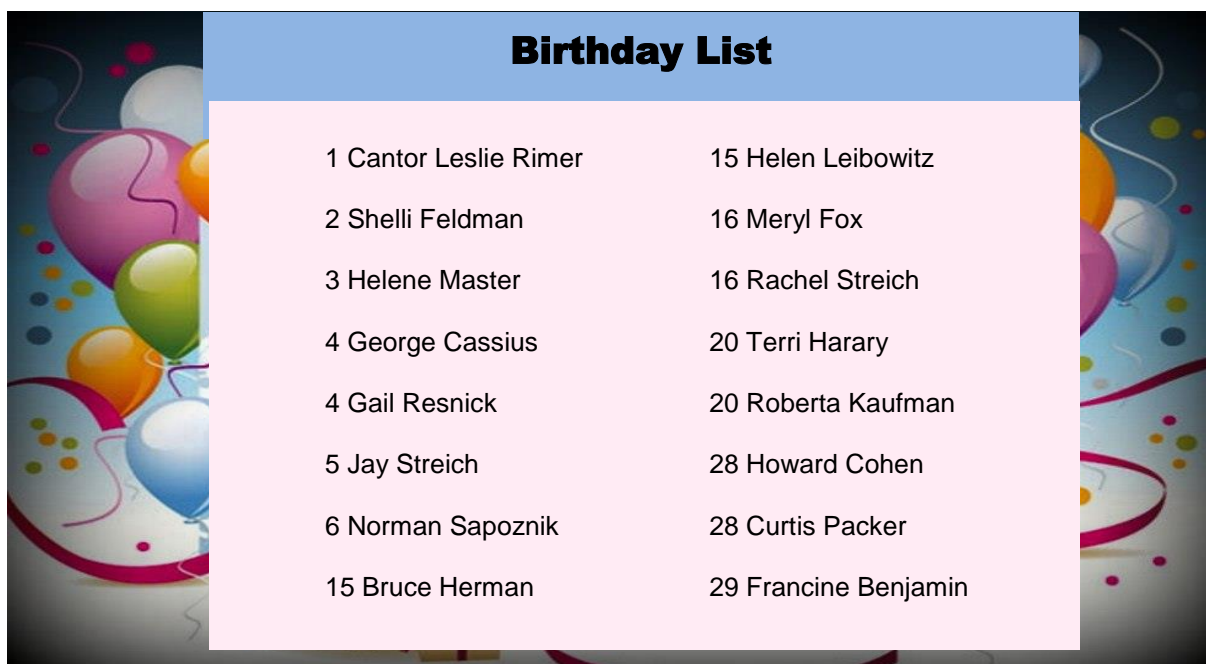
