**MESSAGE ARTICLE – March 2022**  
**PURIM-A MODERN HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE**  
**Rabbi Shae J. Kane D.D.**

The Book of *Esther* is the only book in the Bible, which does not mention God's name, and the only book which contains the word, *Kasher*, meaning 'fit.' The Hebrew word *Mishteh* (banquet) occurs twenty times in the Book of *Esther*, which is equal to the total of all the other times it is found in the rest of the Bible. At one time *Purim* was known as *Mordecai's Day*, in honor of the hero of the Book of *Esther*. In the states of Missouri and Louisiana there are towns called *Esther*. In the latter state there is also a town known as *Estherwood*.

On *Purim* in 1870, one of the earliest Jewish colonies of what was then Palestine, *Mikveh Israel*, famed for its agricultural school, was founded. From a New York newspaper on *Purim*-March 16, 1883- "The grand fancy-dress ball of the Purim Association at the Academy of Music last night was a brilliant success. The festivities opened at 10:30 with an elegant tableau. On a lofty throne covered with rich drapery and glittering with Eastern decoration were seated the good Queen *Esther*, accompanied by the Prince and Princess Carnival, attended by brilliant retinues in gorgeous costumes. The robes of the royal personages represented were the richest ever seen in this country; that of Queen *Esther* was claimed to be a correct copy of the original. The source of authority on this interesting point was not explicitly stated."

On *Purim* in 1912, a handful of women gathered in the vestry rooms of Temple Emanuel in New York. They constituted themselves the Hadassah Chapter of a national organization to be known as the Daughters of *Zion*. The Feast of *Purim*, on which the meeting was held, made the name of *Hadassah* almost inevitable, for the word, which means 'myrtle,' was the Hebrew name of Queen *Esther*; and eventually it supplanted the 'Daughters of *Zion*.' Thirty-eight women subscribed as members. Henreitta Szold spoke on the need of a 'definite project,' and shortly after that she was elected president.

On October 16, 1946, ten sons of the hmn of our own day, n-zi chieftains, were hung on gallows at Nuremberg, Germany, as a punishment for monstrous crimes committed against humanity. A remarkable aspect of the celebration of *Purim* is that it commemorates -not the hanging of hmn and his sons, or the descendants of like-minded people throughout history and into the modern age - but the saving of the Jewish People.

## President's Message    March 2022

The month of March is a time to celebrate the end of winter and the coming of a spring full of promise and hope. We hope for warmer weather and the budding of flowers and leaves on trees. We also celebrate one of Judaism's most inspiring stories, the story of Purim. Purim tells the story of the bravery of Queen Esther, the bravery of her uncle Mordechai, and the triumph of the Jewish people over the evil of Haman and his followers. It is no wonder that Hitler and the Nazis particularly hated this story of the Hebrew bible.

The greatest lesson we learn from the story of Purim is that we all have a responsibility to stand up to injustice, even if we are not the victims of the particular injustice. After all, in the immortal words of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., "an injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere."

In Deuteronomy, Jews are commanded "Justice, justice shall you pursue." The Jewish concept of justice is so important, that it is mentioned twice in the same sentence. The word "shall" instead of "should" also shows how important it is. It is a command, not a suggestion, that Jews must follow.

"At its core, the Purim story is one of good versus evil. In ancient Persia, the king's advisor Haman plots to exterminate the Jewish community. But the Jewish Queen Esther stands in his way and risks her life to expose his plans to the king. In Esther's footsteps, we have a responsibility to stand up to injustice in our world today—to fight for women's rights and human rights, speak truth to power, and stand with persecuted communities around the globe." American Jewish World Service

So, this March, as we watch the last snows of winter melt into the warmth of spring, enjoy some hamantaschen in symbolic celebration of the Jewish liberation from Haman's evil plot. Let's also remember those in our communities who have fallen victim to religious, racial, sexual, and every other form of injustice and speak out on their behalf. Just ask yourself, "what would Esther have done?"
